Be a Smart SCAM SPOTTER

5 Popular Scams and What They're About

Staying vigilant against scams is essential to protecting your finances and personal information. Knowing the signs can help you avoid falling victim to fraud. Let's break down five common scams, their hallmarks, and how to report them.

1. IRS Scams Scammers impersonate IRS agents, claiming you owe back taxes or face arrest. They often demand immediate payment via gift cards or wire transfers. Hallmarks of this scam include unsolicited calls, threats of arrest, and demands for immediate payment. If you suspect this scam, report it to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax

Administration (TIGTA) at 1-800-366-4484 or visit www.treasury.gov/tigta.

- 2. Debt Collection Scams Fraudsters pose as debt collectors, using aggressive tactics to pressure victims into paying fake debts. They often refuse to provide written validation of the debt and may threaten legal action. If you encounter these signs, file a complaint with the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) at 1-855-411-2372 or visit www. consumerfinance.gov/complaint.
- 3. Lottery, Sweepstakes, and Gift Scams Scammers claim you've won a prize but request upfront fees to claim it. They create urgency, pressuring you to act quickly. Be wary of unsolicited prize notifications and requests for fees. Report these scams to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) at 1-877-382-4357 or visit www.reportfraud.ftc.gov.
- 4. Employment Scams Fraudulent job offers promise high pay for little work or request personal information upfront. Hallmarks include offers without interviews, requests for fees, or demands for sensitive data. If you suspect an employment scam, report it through the FTC Complaint Assistant at 1-877-382-4357 or visit www.reportfraud.ftc. gov. You can also explore resources at the National Credit Union Administration's Fraud Prevention Center at www.ncua.gov/consumers/financial-literacy-resources/fraudprevention-center.
- **5. Online Purchase Scams** Fake online stores lure shoppers with too-good-to-be-true deals. Common warning signs are unsecured payment options and missing contact information. If you've fallen victim to this scam, file a complaint with the Better Business Bureau (BBB) at 1-703-276-0100 or visit www.bbb.org, or contact the FTC.

Staying informed and cautious is your best defense. If you suspect a scam, take immediate action by reporting it to the appropriate authorities. For more resources, visit the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) at www.ncua.gov. Together, we can outsmart scammers and keep your financial well-being secure.


